Innovations for XL Pleat

Due to the growing demand for XL Pleat from different markets Coulisse introduces several new developments for this unique system for 50 mm pleated blinds. Apart from a new chain mechanism for the easy and effortless operation of bigger systems Coulisse presents top-down, highly innovative for XL Pleat. Top-down enables you to raise the blind to the desired height and to drop the top of the blind downwards as well creating privacy and the desired light.

Top-down can easily be integrated into the existing XL Pleat system from Coulisse.

Furthermore Coulisse has extended its collection of 50 mm pleated fabrics. Apart from Japanese Paper the new collection offers 13 varieties among which one black-out and several Trevira CS fabrics. Beautiful natural colours as well as sparkling white tones are part of the collection. Eye catcher is fabric Venezia in which silver threads are embroidered in a delicate circle pattern. A cheerful effect is created with double-woven voile fabric Ferrara.



Beautiful additions to Nature Concept collection

Coulisse further extended the extensive collection of natural fabrics for 2010. New in the Nature Concept collection are woven paper fabrics Bali and Java and an exceptional collection designed by designer Nil Lee.

Nil Lee mainly used jute and paper for this collection in order to create a beautiful light. The collection offers 5 varieties in several colours. The fabrics are suitable for roll-ups, roller and panel blinds and partly for roman shades. They are available in a width of 200 cm. With a selection from this collection calmness and balance is brought into the interior.

New for XL Venetian is Bamboo Wood. This material is available in five matt colour tones. The sanded wood texture has a beautiful natural look and gives the interior life style allure. The wood perfectly suits today's interior design and beautifully completes a classical as well as a modern style. Bamboo Wood is available from stock and also in a width of 25 mm.



Must-have panel clips

Coulisse presents exclusive design clips for panel blinds. The magnetic panel clips are available in three

wood varieties and in three aluminium varieties, perfectly suiting all different kind of styles. The clips are attached to the sides of the panels by means of powerful magnets, which make them suitable

for nearly all types of fabric. The panels can now be moved by holding the clips, ensuring the fabrics to stay clean. Furthermore the clips give the panels an extra designer touch.
